







CASE STUDY: COMPTON VERNEY LODGE COMPTON VERNEY CONSERVATION AREA

Overview:

Compton Verney Lodge is on the edge of the grounds of the Compton Verney Estate.
Compton Verney Estate is a conservation area of stunning parkland, over 120 acres.
The parkland was designed by Lancelot 'Capability' Brown and includes a Grade 2* 18th century country mansion.

Challenge:

Obtain planning approval for extensions and alterations within a conservation area.

Solution:

Retain 19th century lodge hierarchy. Use high quality traditional design and materials.

Result:

The proposals demonstrate a resourceful and sympathetic design. The extension houses a speed boat and loose equipment in the garden and drive which was an eyesore.
